

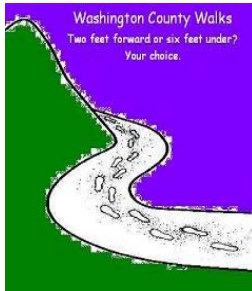

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COMMUNITY TRACKS

Barlow

- **Barlow "Boord" Walk** (0.56 miles - paved surface) - Located at the Barlow Fairgrounds on the corner of SR 550 and SR 339.

Belpre

- **Civitan Park** (0.76 miles - paved surface) - Located along the Ohio River and accessible from Blennerhassett Avenue and Washington Boulevard.
- **Depot Park** (0.2 miles - paved surface) - Accessible from Depot Street.

Decatur

- **Decatur Community Track** (0.22 miles - paved surface) - Located behind the Decatur Community Building at 6505 SR 555.

Little Hocking

- **Belpre Township Recreation Park** (0.43 miles - paved surface) - Accessible from SR 124.

Lowell

- **Buell Park** (0.45 miles - paved surface) - Located on Buell Island.

Marietta

- **Dyson Baudo Recreation Center** (0.125 miles - athletic track surface) - Located on the campus of Marietta College.
- **Kiwanis Fitness Trail at Indian Acres Park** (0.94 mile - paved surface) - Located off of Muskingum Drive between the Washington County Fairgrounds and the Marietta Aquatic Center.

COMMUNITY TRACKS

Marietta - Cont.

- **Lookout Park** (0.33 mile - crushed cinder surface) - Accessible from Lancaster Street.
- **Marietta RiverTrail** (1.94 miles - paved surface) - Extending from Marietta Harbor on Butler Street to Indian Acres Park.
- **Muskingum Park** (0.58 miles - paved surface) - Located along the Muskingum River and accessible from Front Street.
- **Sacra Via Park** (paved surface) - The path between Front and Second Streets is 0.15 miles and the path between Second and Third Streets is 0.20 miles.
- **WASCO Trails** (0.28 miles—paved surface) - Accessible from Davis Avenue.

New Matamoras

- **New Matamoras Community Track** (0.4 miles - paved surface) - Accessible from Grandview Hill Road.

Oak Grove

- **Oak Grove Recreation Center** - Site of a future walking path.

Tunnel

- **Inman Liberty Park** (0.24 miles - paved surface) - Located off of SR 550 on Coffman Road.

Waterford

- **Waterford Fairgrounds** (0.25 miles - paved surface) - Located at the Waterford Fairgrounds off of SR 339.



NATURE TRAILS

Boord State Nature Preserve

- **Boord Nature Trail** (0.66 mile - natural trail surface) - Travel west on SR 550 through Layman, turn left onto Burnett Road/CR 6, and then turn right onto Falls Run Road.

- **821 Entrance Trail** (0.3 miles - natural trail surface) - The trailhead and parking area is located off of SR 821 approximately 1 mile from SR 60. Follow red markers.
- **Northern Ridge Trail** (0.65 miles - natural trail surface) - The trail is most accessible by the 821 Entrance Trail or the Western Ridge Trail. Follow yellow markers.
- **Powerline Trail** (0.9 miles - natural trail surface) - The trail is most accessible by the 821 Entrance Trail. This trail is unmarked. Follow the power lines.
- **Southwest Overlook Trail** (0.6 miles - natural trail surface) - This trail is only accessible by the Western Ridge Trail. Follow green markers.
- **Valley Trail** (0.9 miles - natural trail surface) - This trail is only accessible at the ends of the Western Ridge, Northern Ridge, or Powerline Trails. Follow orange markers
- **Western Ridge Trail** (0.95 miles - natural trail surface) - This trail is most accessible by the SR 60 entrance behind Marietta Bible College. Follow blue markers.



NATURE TRAILS

North Country Trail

America's Longest Hiking Trail

- **NCT (Kris-Mar Greenspace Section)** - (0.65 miles - natural trail surface) - Trailheads are located behind Biehl-Hawn Insurance in the Frontier Shopping Center and near the intersection of Glendale and Colgate in Marietta. **Frontier Loop Trail, Glendale Trail, and Overlook Loop Trail** are all natural surface trails that are less than a mile in length and accessible from the NCT in the Kris-Mar Greenspace.
- **NCT (WSCC Section)** - (1.9 miles - natural trail surface) - Trail heads are located near the intersection of Colgate and Glendale and at the dead end of Terrace Avenue in Marietta.
- **NCT (Wayne National Forest)** - The NCT extends 41 miles through Wayne National Forest.
- **NCT (Information)** - The Kris-Mar Greenspace and WSCC sections are connected by a 0.4 mile section along Glendale Road. The remainder of the NCT in Marietta will follow sidewalks that will link it to the eastern and western city limits. It is about 7 miles from the eastern city limits to the trailhead at Lane Farm Campground (SR 26) in Wayne National Forest. The NCT is always distinguished by blue markers.



NATURE TRAILS

- **Archers Fork Trail** (9.5 miles - natural trail surface) - The looping trail is located off of HWY 260 between New Matamoras and Bloomfield.
- **Covered Bridge Trail** (5 miles - natural trail surface) - The trail is accessible from either the Haught Run or Hune Bridge entrances along HWY 26 north of Marietta.
- **Kinderhook Trail** (16 miles - natural trail surface) - The trailhead is accessible from CR 244 near Newport.
- **Leith Run Recreational Area** (0.5 miles - paved surface) - The area is located off of SR 7 between Newport and New Matamoras.
- **Ohio Valley Trail** (7 miles - natural trail surface) - The trail begins 3 miles north of Leith Run on SR 7 and ends at SR 260 near the community of Yellow House.
- **Scenic River Trail** (3.4 miles - natural trail surface) - The trail begins at the Leith Run Recreational Area on SR 7 and ends on CR 9 near German Cemetery.



NATURE TRAILS

More Trails

- **Decatur Buckeyes 4-H Nature Trails** - Multiple, intersecting natural surface trails of varying lengths that link from Belpre Township Recreation Park in Little Hocking.
- **Gannett Nature Trail for All** - (0.15 miles - paved surface) - Located to the front left of the Washington County Career Center on SR 676.
- **Kroger Wetland** - (0.52 miles - natural trail surface) - The trailhead is behind the Marietta Kroger, and is accessible from Acme Street in Marietta.
- **Marietta Trail of Discovery** - Marietta High School will be the future site of a two-loop trail system that will be open to the public in the fall of 2007.
- **Washington County Career Center Trails** - Located to the rear left of Washington County Career Center on SR 676 are multiple, intersecting trails of varying lengths. The trails are unmarked.
- **Waterford Nature Trail** - (2 miles - natural trail surface) - The trailhead is located behind Waterford Elementary School on SR 339.
